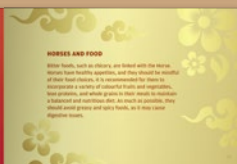

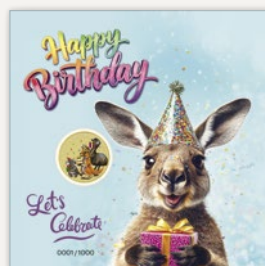

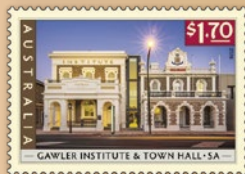

# Regional Heritage Australia

Showcasing magnificent, heritage-listed buildings from the 19th century.

This stamp issue features four significant buildings located in three regional Australian towns: the Bathurst Courthouse in New South Wales, which was opened in 1880; the Marvel Bar Hotel, built in 1898 in the then-prosperous gold-mining town of Coolgardie, Western Australia; and the Gawler Institute building and the adjacent Town Hall, completed in 1871 and 1878 respectively in the South Australian town of Gawler.

# Endangered Birds

Highlighting some of the birds at risk of extinction.

Since European colonisation, around 29 Australian bird species and subspecies have become extinct. It's also estimated that one in six species are currently under threat. This issue features bird species classified nationally as endangered or critically endangered under the EPBC (Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation) Act. They include Carnaby's Black Cockatoo, the tiny Mallee Emu-wren and the lively Capricorn Yellow Chat. All illustrations are by award-winning watercolour artist Frances McMahon.

# Creatures of the Palaeozoic

The creatures that lived on our continent 500 million years ago.

In the early Cambrian Period of the Palaeozoic Era, organisms had not yet emerged from the water to live on land. But they had developed skeletons, shells and other hard structures through the process of biomineralisation. The fossils of these extraordinary creatures were found in Emu Bay Shale deposits on Kangaroo Island, South Australia. The artist for this stamp issue, Peter Trusler, collaborated with Associate Professor Diego Garcia-Bellido, a palaeontologist at the University of Adelaide, to create these accurate illustrations.

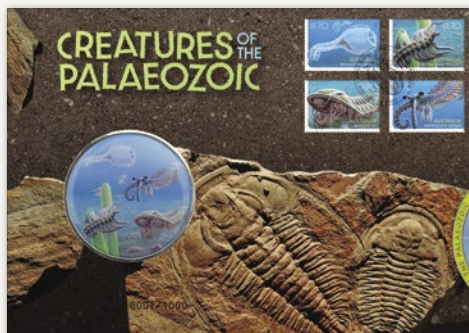

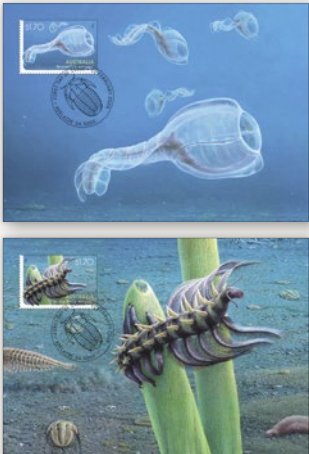
**"Emu Bay Shale Monster"**  
SPINY LOBOSPOON

This is an exceptionally rare animal, with only one specimen known, so it has not been assigned to any known genus or species. The body is not complete but would have been more than four centimetres long. This soft-bodied, worm-like creature is a rare relative of modern-day velvet worms, which are considered to be the closest living relatives of the extinct creature. It had a segmented body, a head with a pair of antennae, and a pair of eyes. The creature is also known for its 'fluffy legs' with a pair of terminal claws in the posterior part. Its informal name of 'Emu Bay Shale Monster' was given after the original 'Velvet Monster' discovered in the Burgess Shale by Dr. Desmond Collins, the leader of the Royal Ontario Museum's Burgess Shale expedition in 1985. This type of spiny lobopod is now called the *Onychophora*.



# Eremophilas: Desert-Loving Flowers

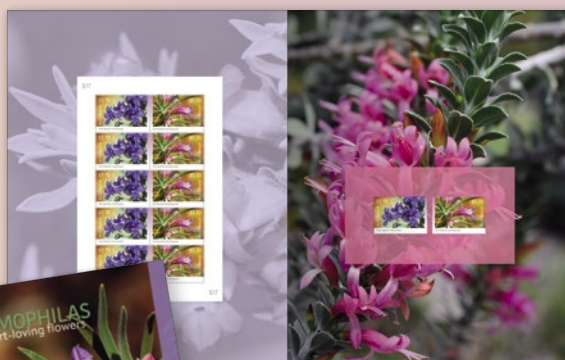
These hardy-yet-beautiful plants are found throughout mainland Australia.

Eremophila is a large genus of flowering plants that thrive on relatively low rainfall and can survive long droughts. In fact, the name Eremophila is derived from ancient Greek terms meaning 'desert loving'. Even in dry conditions, they can produce masses of flowers, which attract birds and insects. For all these reasons, Eremophilas are becoming increasingly popular as garden plants in our warming climate.



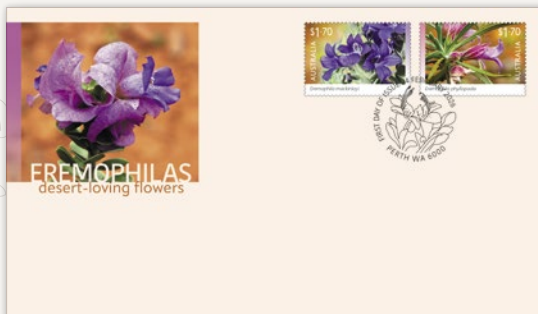
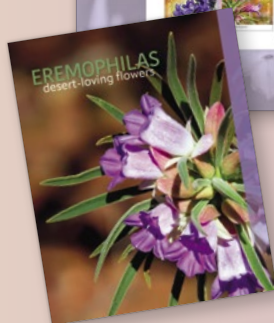
