



What is a DigiStamp?

A DigiStamp is a physical stamp that comes with a free digital collectable counterpart. They're both issued by Australia Post. The physical stamp can be used for postal services, while the digital collectable provides access to an image.






WB Gould's Sketchbook of Fishes

Fish watercolours recognised as treasure.

Convict artist William Buelow Gould (c. 1803-1853) created his masterpiece while imprisoned at Macquarie Harbour's Sarah Island penal colony in 1832. As servant to medical officer Dr William de Little, Gould painted 36 delicate watercolour studies of fish and shellfish. This sketchbook, now at Allport Library and Museum of Fine Arts, Hobart, was added to UNESCO's Australian Memory of the World Register in 2011.





The Art of Eileen Mayo

Iconic Australian stamp and poster designer.

British-born artist Eileen Mayo (1906-1994) was a multi-talented painter, printmaker and designer. After emigrating to Australia in 1952, Mayo designed stamps for the Postmaster-General's Department, including six depicting Australian animals and four marine life stamps in 1966 for the new decimal currency. Her work gained international acclaim: in 1960, her platypus was awarded equal first place by the British Stamp Collector's Annual, and in 1961 her bilby ranked among the world's top 10 designs. She also created travel posters for ANTA.



Defining moments in our country's social history.

This issue celebrates three iconic Australian photographers. David Moore (1927-2003) captured European migrants arriving in Sydney with anticipation and trepidation in 1966. Mervyn Bishop (1945-), Australia's first Indigenous professional photographer, documented the historic 1975 moment when Prime Minister Gough Whitlam symbolically returned Gurindji land to traditional owner Vincent Lingiari. Anne Zahalka (1957-) reimagined Australian beach culture in *The Bathers* 1989, reflecting post-war multi-cultural diversity.





100 Years: Birth of Queen Elizabeth II

Celebrating the life of the late British monarch.

Queen Elizabeth II was born Elizabeth Alexandra Mary on 21 April 1926. She was just 25 when she acceded to the throne upon the death of her father, King George VI, on 6 February 1952. Elizabeth was the first British monarch to visit Australia, touring with Prince Philip in 1954, and made a total of 16 visits to our shores. She died on 8 September 2022 at the age of 96.



Preparing for Peace: World War I Posters


Australians are called on to help rebuild the country.

After World War I, peace bonds were issued to help the government recover the costs of war and support ex-servicemen. The peace bonds were promoted in various ways, including newspaper advertising, banners, public meetings and ephemera such as posters. These posters appealed to emotions such as patriotism, thrift, gratitude and hope; imagery often included women and children as well as military figures.




