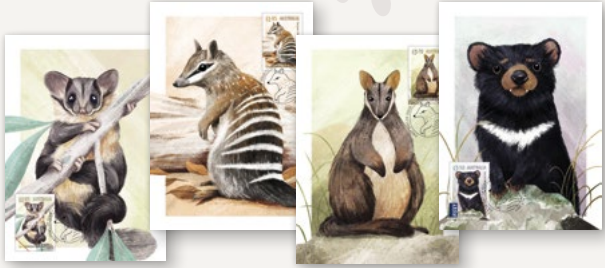

Annette Kellerman held all world records for women's swimming at the age of just 16. Athletics star Decima Norman won five gold medals at the British Empire Games (now the Commonwealth Games) in 1938. And Francis (Frank) Ponta competed in five Paralympic Games, winning one gold, two silver and one bronze medal.

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Paralympian of the Year

Ben Tudhope is honoured for a second time.

The Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games took place between 6 and 15 March 2026, marking the 50th anniversary of the first Paralympic Winter Games. The star of the show was Ben Tudhope, who won both of Australia's medals: a silver and a bronze in Para snowboard. The events were the men's snowboard cross SB-LL2 and men's banked slalom SB-LL2.

In acknowledgement of his achievements, in July 2026 Ben was awarded Paralympian of the Year. This is the second time Ben has been honoured with this award; he was also the 2022 Paralympian of the Year.
